**2017 SUMMER ENRICHMENT CAMP**

**FACT SHEET**

Tuesday, June 6<sup>th</sup> – Friday, July 28<sup>th</sup>, 2017

Monday – Friday ~ 8:30 am – 3:00 pm

**MANDATORY PARENT ORIENTATION: Monday, June 5<sup>th</sup>, 2017 at 7:00 p.m.**

- ❖ Registration begins Monday, March 6<sup>th</sup> (*Membership Dues must be current*)
- ❖ Registration is on a first come, first serve basis. However, Students enrolled in the Academic Enhancement (After-School) Program, of **good standing** status, are given first consideration.
- ❖ Camp is open to Students in Grades K – 6<sup>th</sup> grade
  - *Must have **completed Kindergarten.***
  - *Students in **Grades K-2 must currently attend a Pinellas County School and Complete Summer Bridge Registration (No Exceptions).***
- ❖ Weekly field trips, t-shirts, breakfast, lunch, and a daily snack are included. If you allow your child(ren) to attend field trips, remember to give them spending money for what they might want to purchase.
- ❖ For safety reasons, students must wear **SNEAKERS ONLY.**
- ❖ Summer Enrichment Camp focus will be: Reading, Math, Writing, and Technology.
- ❖ Parent(s) or Guardian(s) **must attend Parent Orientation on Monday, June 5<sup>th</sup>.** Any student not represented by an adult at the orientation will be removed from the list and not admitted into the program.
- ❖ In order to participate in the Camp Final Field Trip (Friday, July 14<sup>th</sup>) **MANDATORY** Attendance is required at the "End of Summer" showcase (Monday, July 10<sup>th</sup>, 7:00 pm) for Parent(s) and Students.

**Morning Drop Off / Evening Pick up**

Someone authorized on the pick-up list **MUST** sign the camper in/out daily. Students may **NOT** arrive on campus prior to 8:00am and are considered tardy after 8:30am (*\*see parent manual*). Camp ends at 3:00 pm and students may be picked up at that time or may remain for after-camp activities.

**Attendance / Tardy Policy**

In order to achieve the greatest educational benefit provided, Students are expected to attend camp daily Monday through Friday.

**THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES WILL APPLY FOR ABSENT/TARDY STUDENTS:**

- All excused absences **must** be accompanied by a doctor's note
- Students **NOT** present by the start of camp on Tuesday, June 6<sup>th</sup> will be withdrawn and placed on the waiting list.
- Any camper that accrues more than Five (5) absences throughout the summer ***will be automatically withdrawn*** for the remainder of camp. **No Exceptions!**
- Students must be present at least Three (3) days during the week to attend any field trip.
- Students arriving later than 8:30 am will be considered tardy.
- Three (3) tardies = One (1) absence (Example: 6 tardies = 2 absences)
- Students will not be accepted into class after 9:30am (unless prior authorization has been declared by the Camp Director)

*(Due to the high demand for entrance into the Summer Enrichment Camp, CAP will adhere **strictly** to the aforementioned policy.)*
